Ways to Support Literacy on the Run

WRITE: child's name, letters, lists, notes, labels, stories. Focus on writing the sounds you hear (invented spellings).

TALK ABOUT: books, television programs, fun time at school, what I learned

SING A SONG OR RHYME: alphabet song, "One Two, Buckle My Shoe", "Humpty Dumpty", "Baa, Baa Black Sheep"

RECOGNIZE LETTERS: on signs, in a book, on license plates, in something we wrote

PLAY SIMPLE WORD GAMES: "I Spy" using the first sound, not the color, rhyme your name, clap sounds in words, draw a rhyme

TELL STORIES: at bedtime, at mealtime, in the car, on a walk
